By the ian Accounts received here from Oczakow; it appears that the Ruffians continued their Operadions againft that Place, anid that the Turks made Frequent Sallies, but that nothing of Importance had Jately happened there:

Viegna, Oabober 22.
The Enpërgr, after vifiting the Fortreftes of Temefuar and Arad, (at the firf of which Places Whathal Pelegrini remains as Governor) returned to the Army on the 15 th Inflant, which on the 16 th had reached a Village called Soka, and was expected to arfive at Apova; on the Banks of the Danubé, this Day or To-miorrow. The Divifion under General Warten!leben, confifing of about 15,000 Men, fạs retaken Poffeffion of Caranfebes, and extended its Patrols as far às Cornia; General Dalion ádvances with his Corps to Werfchetz and Weifkirchen. The Turks remain Matters of Meadia, Schupaneck and Orfova; but they have abandoned Panfova; and Their principal Force occupies the two Banks of the Danabe in the Neighbourhood of Belgrade:
