Westminster, February 3.

HIS Day the Lords being met, a Meffage was fent to the Honourable Houfe of Commons, by Sir Francis Molyneux, Gentleman Ufher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that The Lords, authorized by Virtue of His Majesty's Commission, do defire the immediate Attendance of this Honourable House in the House of Pecers to hear the Commission read; and the Commons being come thither, the faid Commission, empowering the Lord Archbishop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, the Lord Prefident of the Council, and feveral other Lords therein named, to hold the faid Parliament, and to open and declare the Caufes of holding the fame, was read in the Prefence of both Houfes.

After which the Earl Bathurft, who fat as Speaker, made the following Speech.

My Lords, and Gentlemen,

IN purfuance of the Authority given Us by His Majelty's Commission under the Great Seal, which has now been read, amongst other Things to declare the Caufes of your prefent Meeting, We have only to call your Attention to the melancholy Circumstance of His Majerty's Illnefs, in confequence of which it becomes neceffary to provide for the Care of His Majefty's Royal Perfon, and for the Administration of the Royal Authority, during the Continuance of this Calamity, in fuch Manner as the Exigency of the Cafe appears to require.
