HIS Day the Lords being met, a Message was fent to the Honourable House of Commons by Sir Francis Molyneux, Gentleman Ufher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that The Lords, authorized by virtue of His Majesty's Commission, for declaring His Royal Assent to several Acts agreed upon by both Houses, do defire the immediate Attendance of this Ho-nourable House in the House of Peers, to bear the Commiffion read; and the Commons being come thither, the faid Commiffion, impowering the Lord Archbishop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and the Marquis of Stafford, Lord Privy Seal, to declare and notify the Royal Affent to the faid Acts, was read accordingly, and the Royal Affent given to

An AE to explain, amend, and render more effectual, feveral Acts, made in the Twenty third Year of the Reign of His late Majefly King George the Second, and the Twelfth Year of the Reign of His prejent Majesty, for improving the Navigation of the River Loyne, otherwise called Lune, and for building a Quav or Wharf near the Town of Lancaster, in the County Palatine of Lancaster, and for other Parposes therein mentioned.

An AA for embanking and draining certain Fens and Low Lands in the Parishes of Nocton and Potter-banworth in the County of Lincoln, and in the Parish of Branston in the County of the City of Lincoln. An AI for dividing and inclosing the Open Common

Fen and Ings in the Parifs of Dunfton in the County of Lincon, and for draining and improving certain Parts thereof, and also certain inclosed Low Lands in the faid Parish, and in the Parish of Metheringham, in the faid County.

An AA to amend and enlarge the Powers of an AA paffed in the last Selfion of Parliament, intituled, An AA for repairing the Church of the Pursh of Saint Paul Covent Garden in the County of Middlefex, for r pairing and improving the Gates and Avenues leading to the faid Church, and for removing the pesent Watch-House and providing another for the Use of the faid Parifh.
