HE King has been pleafed to conflitute and appoint the Right Honourable Wil-liam Pitt, the Honourable Edward James Eliot, the Right Honourable Richard Earl of Mornington of the Kingdom of Ireland, Knight of the Illustrious Order of St. Patrick, the Right Honourable John Jefferies Pratt, commonly called Lord Viscount Bayham, and the Right Honourable Henry Bathurft, commonly called Lord Apfley, to he Commissioners for executing the Office of Treafurer of His Majefty's Exchequer.

The King has been pleafed to grant to Charles Shaw, of Lincoln's Inn, Efq; Barrifler at Law, his Royal Licence and Authority to affume and use the Surname, and bear the Arms of Lefevre, when and as foon as his intended Marriage with Helena Lefevre, only Child of John Lefevre, of Oldford in the County of Middlefex, Efq; fhall have been fo-lemnized; fuch Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Haralde Office: Heralds Office :

The King has also been pleafed to grant George Potter, of Pole, in the County of Chelter, Esq; and his Iffue, His Royal Licence and Authority to affume and take the Name of Eaton, and also to bear the Arms of Eaton, purfuant to the laft Will of George Eaton, late of Pole aforefaid, Elq; deceafed; fuch Arms being duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds Office :

And also to order that these His Majesty's several Concessions and Declarations be regultered in His College of Arms.
