The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREAS the Time limited by His Ma-May last, for granting Bounties for the Encou-taging of Seamen and Landmen to enter themselves on Board His Majesty's Ships of War, and Rewards for discovering Seamen who may secrete themselves, will expire on the Thirtieth Day of this instant June: And whereas it is judged expedient for His Majesty's Service; that the said Bounties and Rewards should continue to be paid for fome Time longer; His Majesty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, That the Time limited by the aforementioned Proclamations for granting the faid Bounties and Rewards be prolonged and extended from the faid Thirtieth Day of this instant June to the Thircy-first Day of August next inclusive, and that the Bounties and Rewards thereby given and granted be continued to be paid until the said Thirty-first Day of August: Whereof all Persons concerned are to take Notice, and govern themselves accordingly.
