THIS Morning Mr. Dressins, one of His Majesty's Messengers in Ordinary, arrived at the Office of his Grace the Duke of Leeds, His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, with Dispatches from the Right Honorable Alleyne Fitz-Herbert, His Majesty's Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary at the Court of Madrid, dated the 24th of October last, containing an Account that a Convention, for terminating the Differences which had arisen with that Court, had been agreed upon between his Excellency, on the Part of His Majesty, and the Count de Florida Blanca, on the Part of the Catholic King; and that the Convention was to be signed and exchanged by those Ministers on the 27th of the same Month.
