THEREAS there was this Day read at the Board, the homble Petition of feveral Merchants of London, in Behalf of themfelves and others trading to Spain, hulphly praying. for the Reafons therein contained, that all Ships coming from the Ports of Spain within the Mediterranean, laden with Froit, Wine, and other Goods not enquerated in the Quarantine Regulations, may, on the fame being verified to the Officers to the Cofforns' at the Porti where fuch Ships may arrive, be freely admitted to Entry without performing Quarantine ; His Majefly, having taken the faid Petition into Confideration, and being defirous to sensore all Obfenctions upon Trade, fo far as may be confident with the Health and Safety of His Subjects, is pleafed, with the Advice of His Privy Conacil, to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the Quarantiae at prefent fubfilling upon all Ships and Veffels coming from or through the Mediterranean, be taken bf, to far as respects Ship: and Veffels coming directly from any of the Ports of the Kingdom of Spain, within the Mediterraneza, or from the Liland of Minorce, inden with the Products of Spain only; and that all fach Ships, and also all Ships and Veffels arriving from the Town or Port of Gibraltar, he permitted to difcharge their refpective Lådings without unpacking, opening and airing, and without performing any Quarantine : Provided that the Cargo on board fuch Ships thall confift entirely of Articles not enumerated in the Orders of Council directing the Performance of Quarantine,

Jars, which tha'l have been folely made use of as Package for the faid non-edumerated Articles : And provided also that they bring with them clean Bills of Health, and that the Mafter or Perion taking Charge of Yuch Ship or Veffei do first make Answer, upon Oath, before the Superintendant of Quarantine, ge other Perfon appointed for that Service, to the printed Questions mustly put to the Matters of Ships coming from Places from whence Quarantine is required to be performed ; and that by the faid Anfwers; which thall be transmitted by the faid Superintendant drother Perfor appointed to fet Quarantine performed, to the Principal Officers of the Cufloms, or to the Chief Magifrate at the Place to which the Ship is bound, it thall appear, to the Sariufaction of the faid. Principal Officers or Chief Magistrate, that fach Ship did not touch at any infeited Place, nor had Communication with any infected Ship or Veffel, during the Voyage, and that the Crew is free from Infection, - And the Lords Commissioners of His Majefty's Treafury, the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Mafter General of the Ordnance, His Majesty's Secretary at War, and the Governors or Commanders in Chief for the Time being of the Illes of Jerley, Guernley, Aldemey, Sark and Man, are to give the needlary Directions herein, 23 to them may respectively appertain.
