THE King has been pleased to order a Congé d'Elire to pass the Great Seal, empowering the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Salisbury to elect a Bishop of that See, void by the Translation of the Right Reverend Father in God Shute, late Bishop thereof, to the See of Durham: And His Majesty has also been pleased, by His Royal Sign Manual, to recommend the Right Reverend Father in God John now Lord Bishop of Carlisle to be Bishop of that See.

The King has also been pleased to present the Reverend John Garnett, Master of Arts, to the Vicarage of Sutterton, in the County of Lincoln and Diocese of the same, void by the Death of Doctor Leonard Beridge.
