THE King has becn pleafed to order a Congé d'Elire to pass the Great Seal, empowring the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Chu.ch of Salibury to eleth a Binop of that See, void by the Tranilation of the Right Reverend Father in God Shute, late Bilhop thereof, to the See of Durham: And His Majefty has alfo been pleaied, by His Reyal Sign Mannal, to recommen: the Right Reverend Father in God John now Lord Bilhoy of Carlile to be Bifhop of that See.

The King has alfo been pleafid to prefent the Reverend John Garneit, Mafter of Artc, to the Vicarage of Sutterron, in the County of Lincoln and Diocefe of the fame, void by the Death of Doctor Leonard Beridge.
