STATE LOTTERY.

Stamp-Office, Somerset-Place, Jan. 12, 1792. HIS Majesty's Commissioners for managing the Stamp Duties think it necessary, at this Period, thus pub-lickly to caution all Persons against buying or felling any Shares of Tickets in the enfuing State Lottery, other than fuch as are legally flamped, or PUBLISHING, IN ANY MANNER, PROPOSALS for fuch Purpofe; the AA bawing prohibited, under large Penalties, the dealing in CHANCES, under any Pretence or Dethe dealing in CHAINCES, under any Pretence or De-vice aubatfoever, which may depend on the Contingency of drawing the faid Tickets; and a recent Judgment, in the Court of King's Bench, baving determined, that the Probibition against PUBLISHING ILLEGAL PROPOSALS applies not only to the Projectors of them, but extends also to the Publishers of Newspapers, of Hand-Bills, or any other Communication of fuch Pro-solute.
