Ε Ť, P E S N R The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. 7HEREAS by an Act, passed in the Thirtyfirst Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for regulating the Importation and Ex-" portation of Corn, and the Payment of the Duty " on Foreign Corn imported, and of the Bounty " on British Corn exported;" it is (among other Things) enacted, " That whenever an Act Ihall have " paffed in the Parliament of Ireland, permitting " the Importation from Great Britain into Ireland " of Wheat, Wheat-Meal or Flour, Rye, Barley, " Beer or Bigg, Oats, Oat-Meal, l'eafe, Beans, " and Indian Corn or Maize, respectively, at Prices " equal to the Prices mentioned in the following " Table, marked E! taken Quarterly according to " the Prices of Wheat, Rye, Peafe, Beans, Barley, " Beer or Bigg, and Oats unground, and of Oat-" Meal, at the Time that the fame shall be im-" ported into that Kingdom, and fubject to no " higher Duties respectively than those specified in " the faid Table, marked E. the Duties to be paid " upon the Importation into Great Britain from " Ireland, and the Province of Quebec, and the " other British Colonies or Plantations in North " America, and also from other Foreign Countries, " of Wheat, Wheat-Meal or Flour, Rye, Barley, " Beer or Bigg, Oats, Oat-Meal, Peafe, Beans, " and Indian Corn or Maize, shall, after the Ex-" piration of Three Calendar Months from the No-" tification, by Order of His Majefty in Council, " to be published in the London Gazette, of such " Act having passed in the Parliament of Ireland, " and during the Continuance of fuch Act, or of " any other Act there passed to the fame Purport

" and Effect, be refpectively regulated and afcer-" tained, according to the Prices of Wheat, Rye, " Barley, Beer or Bigg, Peafe, Beans, Oats and " Oat-Meal, in the Manner fet forth and specified " in the faid Table, marked E."

And whereas an Act has passed in the Parliament of Ireland, intituled, " An ASt for the Encrease of " Agriculture and Commerce, by eftablishing a re-" ciprocal Preference in the Corn Trade between " this Kingdom [Ireland] and Great Britain," with a Table annexed thereunto; marked A.; and another Act has passed in the faid Parliament of Ireland, intituled, " An A& for continuing and amending " feveral Laws relating to His Majesty's Revenue; " and for more effectually preventing Frauds " therein," with a Table annexed thereunto, marked E.; by the former of which Two Acts of the Parliament of Ireland, and the Table thereunto annexed, the Importation is permitted from Great Britain into Ireland of Wheat, Wheat-Meal or Flour; Rye, Barley, Beer or Bigg, Oats, and Oat-Meal; and by the latter of which Two Acts, and the Table thereunto annexed, the Importation is permitted from Great Britain into Ireland of Peafe, Beans, and Indian Corn or Maize respectively, at Prices equal to the Prices mentioned in the Table, marked E. annexed to the faid Act, passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, taken Quarterly, according to the Prices of Wheat, Rye, Peafe, Beans, Barley, Beer or Bigg, and Oats unground, and of Oatmeal, at the Time that the fame shall be imported into that Kingdom, and fubject to no higher Duties refpec: tively than those specified in the faid Table, marked E.

His Majelty in Council is pleafed to notify, and doth hereby notify, that the faid Acts have paffed inthe Parliament of Ireland, and that by virtue of the faid
