The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS by an Act, passed in the Thirty-first Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for regulating the Importation and Exportation of Corn, and the Payment of the Duty on Foreign Corn imported, and of the Bounty on British Corn exported;" it is (among other Things) enacted, "That whenever an Act shall have passed in the Parliament of Ireland, permitting the Importation from Great Britain into Ireland of Wheat, Wheat-Meal or Flour, Rye, Barley, Beer or Bigg, Oats, Oat-Meal, Pease, Beans, and Indian Corn or Maize, respectively, at Prices equal to the Prices mentioned in the following Table, marked E: taken Quarterly according to the Prices of Wheat, Rye, Pease, Beans, Barley, Beer or Bigg, and Oats unground, and of Oat-Meal, at the Time that the same shall be imported into that Kingdom, and subject to no higher Duties respectively than those specified in the said Table, marked E. the Duties to be paid upon the Importation into Great Britain from Ireland, and the Province of Quebec, and the other British Colonies or Plantations in North America, and also from other Foreign Countries, of Wheat, Wheat-Meal or Flour, Rye, Barley, Beer or Bigg, Oats, Oat-Meal, Pease, Beans, and Indian Corn or Maize, shall, after the Expiration of Three Calendar Months from the Notification, by Order of His Majesty in Council, to be published in the London Gazette, of such Act having passed in the Parliament of Ireland, and during the Continuance of such Act, or of any other Act there passed to the same Purport

and Effect, be respectively regulated and ascertained, according to the Prices of Wheat, Rye, Barley, Beer or Bigg, Pease, Beans, Oats and Oat-Meal, in the Manner set forth and specified in the said Table, marked E."

And whereas an Act has passed in the Parliament of Ireland, intituled, "An Act for the Encrease of Agriculture and Commerce, by establishing a reciprocal Preference in the Corn Trade between this Kingdom [Ireland] and Great Britain," with a Table annexed thereunto, marked A.; and another Act has passed in the said Parliament of Ireland, intituled, "An Act for continuing and amending several Laws relating to His Majesty's Revenue; and for more effectually preventing Frauds therein," with a Table annexed thereunto, marked E.; by the former of which Two Acts of the Parliament of Ireland, and the Table thereunto annexed, the Importation is permitted from Great Britain into Ireland of Wheat, Wheat-Meal or Flour; Rye, Barley, Beer or Bigg, Oats, and Oat-Meal; and by the latter of which Two Acts, and the Table thereunto annexed, the Importation is permitted from Great Britain into Ireland of Pease, Beans, and Indian Corn or Maize respectively, at Prices equal to the Prices mentioned in the Table, marked E. annexed to the said Act, passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, taken Quarterly, according to the Prices of Wheat, Rye, Pease, Beans, Barley, Beer or Bigg, and Oats unground, and of Oatmeal, at the Time that the same shall be imported into that Kingdom, and subject to no higher Duties respectively than those specified in the said Table, marked E.

His Majesty in Council is pleased to notify, and doth hereby notify, that the said Acts have passed in the Parliament of Ireland, and that by virtue of the
