PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

TATHEREAS by an Act passed in this prefent Seffion of Parliament, intituled, " An Act " for indemnifying all Perfons who have been con-" cerned in advifing or carrying into Execution an " Order of Council respecting the Exportation of Wheat and Wheat Flour; for preventing Suits in " confequence of the fame, and for making further " Provisions relative thereto; and also for autho-" rizing His Majesty to prohibit the Exportation of " Corn, Meal, Flour, Bread, Bifcuit and Potatoes; " and to permit the Importation of Corn, Meal or " Flour on the Low Duties ;" His Majesty is authorized, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, until the End of the prefent Seffion of Parliament, to permit generally, for a limited Time, the Importation of Foreign Corn, Meal or Flour, fubject to either of the Low Duties specified in the Table D, in the Act passed in the 31st Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for regulating the Importation « and Exportation of Corn, and the Payment of the se Duty on Foreign Corn imported, and of the " Bounty on British Corn exported;" and in like Manner to recall fuch Permifion, if Circumstances shall appear to to require : His Majesty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, by virtue of the Powers vefted in him by the first above recited Act, hereby order, that it shall be lawful, during the Space of Four Months from the Date of this Order in Council, to import into any Port of this Kingdom any Foreign Rye and Rye-Meal, at the loweft Duty specified in the faid Table

D, in the faid Act passed in the 31st Year of His Majesty's Reign: And the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury are to give the necessary Directions herein accordingly. *W. Fawhener.*

THEREAS by an Act passed in the Twentyeighth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, intituled, "An Act for regulating the Trade " between the Subjects of His Majefty's Colonies " and Plantations in North America and in the " West India Islands, and the Countries belonging " to the United States of America, and between " His Majefty's faid Subjects and the Foreign Islands " in the Weft Indies," it is, amongst other Things, enacted, That it Gall and may be lawful for His Majefty in Council, by Order or Orders to be iffued and published from Time to Time, to authorize, or by Warrant or Warrants, under His Sign Manual, to impower the Governor of Newfoundland for the Time being to authorize, in cafe of Neceffity, the Importation into Newfoundland of Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, from any of the Territories belonging to the faid United States, for the Supply of the Inhabitants and Fishermen of the Island of Newfoundland, for the then enfuing Seafon only; provided always, that fuch Bread, Flour, Indian Corn, and Live Stock, fo authorized to be imported into the Island of Newfoundland, shall not be imported except in conformity to fuch Rules, Regulations and Reffrictions as shall be specified in such Order or Orderss Warränt
