'The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

THEREAS by an Act passed in this present Session of Parliament, intituled, " An Act -er for indemnifying all Perfons who have been con-" cerned in advising or carrying into Execution an Goder of Council respecting the Exportation of " Wheat and Wheat Flour; for preventing Suits in " consequence of the same, and for making further " Provisions relative thereto; and also for autho-" rizing His Majesty to prohibit the Exportation of " Corn, Meal, Flour, Bread, Biscuit and Potatoes; " and to permit the Importation of Corn, Meal or " Flour on the Low Ducies;" His Majesty is authorized, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, until the End of the present Session of Parliament, to permit generally, for a limited Time, the Importation of Foreign Corn, Meal or Flour, subject to either of the Low Duties specified in the Table D, in the Ast passed in the 31st Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for regulating the Importation and Exportation of Corn, and the Payment of the " Duty on Foreign Corn imported, and of the " Bounty on British Corn exported;" and in like Manner to recall fuch Permission, if Circumstances

fore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, by virtue of the Powers vested in him by the first above recited Act, hereby order, that it shall be lawful, during the Space of Four Months from the Date of this Order in Council, to import into any Port of this Kingdom any Foreign Rye and Rye-Meal, at the lowest Duty specified in the said Table D, in the faid Act passed in the 31st Year of His Majesty's Reign: And the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury are to give the necessary Directions herein accordingly.
