The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREAS divers injurious Proceedings have lately been had in France in derogation of the Honour of His Majefty's Crown, and of the juft Rights of His Subjects: And whereas feveral unjuft Seizures have been there made of the Ships and Goods of His Majesty's Subjects, contrary to the Law of Mations, and to the Faith of Treaties : And whereas the faid Acts of unprovoked Hoftility have been followed by an open Declaration of War against His Majesty, and His Ally the Republick of the United Provinces ; His Majefty, therefore, being determined to take fuch Measures as are necessary for vindicating the Honour of His Crown, and for procuring Reparation and Satisfaction for His injured Subjects, is pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, that General Reprizals be granted against the Ships, Goods and Subjects of France, fo that as well His Majesty's Fleet and Ships, as also all other Ships and Veffels that shall be commissionated by Letters of Marque or General Reprizals, or otherwife, by His Majesty's Commissioners for executing the .Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, fhall and may lawfully feize all Ships, Veffels and Goods belonging to France, or to any Perfons being Subjects of France, or inhabiting within any of the Territories of France, and bring the fame

T the Court at the Queen's Haufe, the 11th of | to Judgment in any of the Courts of Admiralty within His Majefty's Dominions; and to that End His Majesty's Advocate-General, with the Advocate of the Admiralty, are forthwith to prepare the Draught of a Commission, and present the same to His Majefty at this Board, authorizing the Commillioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, or any Perfon or Perfons by them empowered and appointed, to iffue forth and grant Letters of Marque and Reprizal to any of His Ma-. jesty's Subjects, or others whom the faid Commiffioners shall deem fitly qualified in that Behalf; for the apprehending, feizing and taking the Ships; Veffels and Goods belonging to France, or to any Perfons being Subjects of France, or inhabiting within any of the Territories of France; and that fuch Powers and Claufes be inferted in the faid Commiffion as have been ufual and are according to former Precedents: And His Majefty's faid Advocate-General, with the Advocate of the Admiralty, are also forthwith to prepare the Draught of a Commission, and present the same to His Majesty at this Board, authorizing the faid Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral to will and require the High Court of Admiralty of Great Britain, and the Lieutenant and Judge of the faid Court, his Surrogate or Surrogates, as also the feveral Courts of Admiralty within His Majefty's Dominions, to take Cognizance of, and judicially proceed upon, all and all Manner of Captures, Seizures, Prizes and Reprizals of all Ships and Goods that are or shall be taken, and
