Р R E ·S Æ N Τ. The KING's Mott Excellent Majefty in Council. 7HEREAS the Time'limited by His Majefty's "Order in Council of the 7th of May last, prohibiting the transporting into any Parts out of this Kingdom any Pot-Ash or Pearl-Ash (except as in the faid Order is mentioned) will expire upon the 7th Day of this instant November : And whereas it is judged expedient that the faid Prohibition should 'be continued for fome Time longer; His Majefty doth therefore, with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit and command, that .no Perfon or Perfons whatfoever do, at any Time during the Space of Six Months from the Date of this Order in Council, export or attempt to export, stransport, carry or convey, or lade or lay on Board of any Ship, Veffel or Boat, in order to be exported, stransported, carried or conveyed out of this Kingdom, any Pot-Afa or Pearl Afh, without Leave or Permiffion being farft had and obtained from His Majefly for His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring the Forfeitures inflicted by an A& paffed in the laft Sellion of Parliament, intituled, " An Act for in. " demnifying all Perfons who have been concerned \*\* in adviling or carrying into Execution an Order "" of the Lords Commissioners of His Majefly's 44 Treafury respecting the Exportation of Pot Ashes " or Pearl-Afries; for preventing Suits in con-" fequence of the fame; for authorizing His Ma-" jefty to prohibit the Exportation or carrying "Coaltwife of Pot-Aftes or Pearl-After, and for

" making further Provisions relative thereto." But it is neverthelefs His Majefty's Pleafure that nothing herein contained shall extend, or be conftrued to extend, to the Exportation of the faid Articles to Ireland, or to His Majerty's Islands of Guerafey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark or Man, or to His Majefty's Colonies or Plantations in America or the West Indies, or to Newfoundland, or to His Majesty's Forts and Settlements on the Coast of Africa, or to the Island of St. Helena, or to the British Settlements or Factories in the East Indies ; provided that, upon the Exportation of the faid Articles to Treland, or to His Majefty's Islands of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark or Man, or to His Majefly's Colonies and Plantations in America or the Welt Indies, or to the Island of Newfoundland, or to His Majefty's Forts and Settlements on the Coaft of Africa, or to the Ifland of St. Helena, or to the British Settlements or Factories in the East Indies, the Exporters of the faid Articles do firk make Oath of the true Deflination of the fame to the Places for which they shall be entered Outwards, before the Entry of the fame fhall be made, and do give full and fufficient Security, by Bond, to the Satisfaction of the Commissioners of His Majefty's Coftoms, to carry the faid Articles to the Places for which they are fo entered Outwards, and none other; and fuch Bond Inall not be cancelled or delivered up until Proof be made, to the Satisfaction of the faid Commiffioners, by the Production, within a Time to be fixed by the faid Commissioners, and fpecified in the Bond, of a Certificate or Certificates, in fuch Form and Manner as fhall be directed by the
