The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. THEREAS by an Act of Parliament passed in the Twenty-fixth Year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act to oblige Ships " more effectually to perform their Quarantine, and for the better preventing the Plague being " brought from Foreign Parts into Great Britain or Ireland, or the Islands of Guernsey, Jetsey, " Alderney, Sark or Man," it is, among many other Things, enacted, That all Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Persons, Goods and Merchandizes whatsoever, coming or imported into any Port or Place with Freat Britain, or any of the Isles beforem ned, from any Place from whence His Mai . His Heirs or Successors, by and with the Adv ... His or Their Privy Council, shall judge it pr 👈 that the Infection may be brought, shall be saged to make their Quarantine in fuch Pl and Places, for fuch Time, and in fuch Mann 1, as has been or shall, from Time to Time, be directed by His Majesty, His Heirs or Succession fors, by His or Their Order or Orders, made in His on Their Privy Council, and notified by Proclamation, or publified in the London Gazette; and that until fuch Ships, Vessels, Persons, Goods and Merchandizes shall have respectively performed and be discharged from such Quarantine, no fuch Person, Goods or Merchandizes, or any of them, shall come or be brought on Shore, or Vessels, Persons, Goods and Merchandize now ar-

T the Court at St. James's, the 12th of No- | go or be put on board any other Ship or Vessel, in any Place within His Majesty's Dominions, unless in fuch Manner, and in such Cases, and by fuch Licence, as shall be directed or permitted by fuch Order or Orders made by His Majesty, His Heirs or Successors, in Council as aforesaid; and that all fuch Ships and Veffels, and the Perfons or Goods coming or imported in, or going or being put on board the fame, and all Ships, Vessels, Boats and Persons receiving any Goods or Persons out of the same, shall be subject to such Orders. Rules and Directions concerning Quarantine, and the Prevention of Infection, as have been or shall be made by His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, in Council, and notified by Proclamation or published in the London Gazette as aforementioned. under such Pains and Penalties as are inflicted by the faid Act.

> And whereas Information has been received that a Fever, which is fimilar in it's Symptoms and Mortality to the malignant and contagious Fever, of the Nature of the Plague, which provailed last Year in Philadelphia, in the State of Pensylvania, has manifested itself at Baltimore in the State of Maryland; His Majesty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, judging it probable that the Infection may be brought into this Kingdom from Baltimore, or some other Port or Place in the said State of Maryland, doth thereupon deem it expedient, for the Safety of the Publick Health, to order, and it is hereby ordered, That all Ships,
