Westminster, March 27.

HIS Day the Lords being met, a Message was sent to the Honourable House of Commons by Sir Francis Molyneux, Knt. Gentleman Wher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that The Lords, authorized by wirtue of His Majesty's Commission for declaring His Royal Assent to several Acts agreed upon by both Houses, do desire the immediate Attendance of this Honourable House in the House of Peers, to bear the Commission read; and the Commons being come thither, the said Commission, impowering the Lord Archbishop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and several other Lords therein named; to declare and notify the Royal Assent given to

An Act for raifing a certain Sum of Money by Loans or Exchequer Bills for the Service of the Year One shouland seven hundred and ninety-five.

An Ast for raising a further Sum of Money by Loans or Exchaquer Bills for the Service of the Year One shousand seven hundred and ninety-sive.

An Act for granting to His Majesty the Sum of Two Hundred Thousand Pounds, to be issued and paid to the Governor and Company of the Bunk of England, to be by them placed to the Account of the Commissioners for the Reduction of the National Debt.

An Act for granting certain Duties of Customs on the Importation of Fruit, Sallad Oil, Waste Silk and Timber, and on the Exportation of British Rock Salt

An AA for rendering more effectual an AA of the clara present Session of Parliament, intituled, An AA for raising a certain Number of Men in the several Counters in England for the Service of His Mujesty's Navy.

An Act for making and maintaining a Turnpike Roud from Mump's Brock, within Oldbam, in the dets.

County Palatine of Lancaster, to Ripponden in the West Riding of the County of York; and a Branch therefrom at or near Denshaw to or near to Brownbill; and another Branch therefrom at or near Grains to Delph, all within Saddleworth in the said Riding.

An Act for repairing and widening the Road from Horseley Upright Gate leading from Bowden Hill, in the County of Wilts, to the Top of Kingsdown Hill, in the Parish of Box in the said County, and several other Roads near or adjoining thereto.

An Ast for repairing and widening the Road from Preston Candover to Basing stoke in the County of Southampton, and from theuce to Alton in the said County. And to Eight Private Bills.

The King has been pleased to grant the Dignity of a Baroness of the Kingdom of Great Britain unto the Right Honorable Susanna Baroness Hood, of the Kingdom of Ireland, by the Name, Stile and Title of Baroness Hood, of Catherington in the County of Southampton, and the Dignity of a Baron of this Kingdom to the Heirs Male of her Body lawfully begotten by the Right Hon. Samuel Baron Hood, of the said Kingdom of Ireland, Admiral of the Blue.

The King has been pleased to grant unto the Hon. William Hay, of Etal in the County of Northumberland, and his Issue, His Royal Licence and Authority to take and use the Surname and bear the Arms of Carr only, pursuant to the last William Testament of his Maternal Grandstather Sir William Carr, of Etal aforesaid, Baronet, deceased; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds Office: And also to order that this His Majetty's Concession and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms.
