WHEREAS His Majefty was pleased, by His Order in Council, bearing Date the 6th of February laft, to order, and it was thereby ordered, That notwithftanding any Thing contained in Two Acts paffed in the 1:ft Seffion of Parliament, referred to in the faid Order, it should be lawful for any Perfon, refiding or being in Great Britain, to pay any Bill drawn or indoried in any Part of the United Provinces, and fent from the faid Pro-. vinces on or before the Sixteenth Day of January laft; provided fuch Bill faculd have been made payable at no greater Diltance of Time than Three Months from the Date thereof, or Three Months from Sight thereof, under certain Conditions in the faid Order contained :-His Majefty, with the Advice of his Privy Council, is hereby pleafed to order, That the Licence, fo granted by the above recited Order of the Sixth of February laft, with respect to the Payment of the Bills therein deferibed, be extended, fubject to the Condition mentioned in the faid Order, to any Bills, drawn or indorfed in any Part of the United Provinces, and feut from the faid Provinces, on or before the faid Sixteenth Day of Janua y laft, which shall have been made payable at no greater Diftance of Time than Five Months from the Date thereof, cr.
