Whitehall, June 23.

As feweral Artificers and Manufacturers, Subjects of Great Britain, have, from Time to Time, gone into Foreign Countries to exercise their foreral Callings, contrary to the Lanvs of these Kingdoms, the filowing Alfracts of Arts of Parliament of Their late Majesties King George the First and Second and of

His projent Majefly, for preventing fuch Prastices, are published, for the Information of all Perfons who may be ignorant of the Penaltics they may incurby Difoledience to them : And it will be observed, that fuch Penalties likewife extent to thefe who are any ways concerned or influmental in the Sending or Extern g Artificers or Manufacturers out of thefe Kingdoms, or in the Expectation of the Tools and Lyleuments and by them, as well as to the Artificers or Manufacturers therefolves.

Statute 5 George I. Chap. 27.

T F any Perion shall contract with, entice, or folicit, any Artificer in Wool, Iron, Steel, Brafs, or other Metal, Clock-maker, Wetch-maker, or any other Atificer of Great Britain, to go into Foreign Countries out of the King's Dominions, and shall be convicted thereof, upon Indictment or Information in any of the Courts at Westminster, or at the Affizes or Quarter-Seffions, he shall be fined any Sam not exceeding ONE HUNDRED POUNDS for the first Offence, and shall be imprifoned Three Months, and till the Fine be paid. And if any Perfon having been once convicted shall offend again he shall be fined at the Diferetion of the Court, and impritoned Twelve Months, and till the Fine be paid.

If any of the King's Subjects, being fuch Artificers, fhall go into any Country out of His Majetly's Dominions, to exercife or teach the faid Trades to Foreigners; and if any of the King's Subjects in any fuch Foreign Country, exercifing any of the faid Trades, fhall not return into this Realm within Six Months after Warning given by the Ambaffador, Minifter or Conful of Great Britain, in the Country where fuch Artifacers fhall be, or by any Perfon authorifed by fuch Ambaffador, &c. or by one of the Secretaries of State, and from henceforth inhabit within this Realm; fuch Perfons fhall be incapable of taking any Legacy, or of being an Executor or Administrator, or of taking any Lands, &c. within this Kingdom, by Defcent, Devife or Purchafe, and fhall forfeit all Lands, Goods, &c. within this Kingdom, to His Majefty's Use, and fhall be deemed Alien, and out of His Majefty's Protection.

Upon Complaint made, upon Oath, before any Jultice of Peace, that any Perfon is endeavouring to feduce any fuch Artificer, or that any fuch Artificer hath contracted or is preparing to go out of His Majefly's Dominions, for the Purpofes afroefaid, fuch Jultice may fend his Warrant to bring the Perfon complained of before him, or before fome other Juffice; and if it fhall appear by the Oath of one Witnefs, or by Confeffion, that he was guilty of any of the faid Offences, fuch Jultice may bind him to appear at the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions: And, if fuch Perfon fhall refufe to give Security, the Juffice may commit him to Goal till the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions, and until he fhall

be delivered by due Courfe of Law. And if any fuch Artificer shall be convicted, upon Indictment, of any fuch Promise, Contract, or Preparation to go beyond the Seas, for the Purpole aforefaid, he shall give such Security to the King not to depart out of His Majeity's Dominions, as such Court shall think reasonable, and shall be imprisoned till Security given.

If any of the above Offences shall be committed in Scotland, the same shall be profecuted in the Court of Judiciary, or the Circuit there.

Statute 23 George II. Chap. 13.

IF any Perfon shall contract with, or endeavout to feduce any Artificer in Wool, Mohair, Cot-ton or Silk, or in Iron, Steel, Brafs, or other Metal, or any Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other Artificer in any other of the Manufactures of Great Britain or Ireland, to go out of this Kingdom or Ireland, into any Foreign Coun-try not within the Dominions of the Crown of Frat Britain, and shall be convicted, upon Indiffment or Information, in the King's Bench at Weitminster, or by Indistment at the Affizes or General Gaol Delivery for the County, &c. wherein fuch Offence shall be committed in England, or by Indicament in the Court of Jufficiary, or any of the Circuit Courts in Scotland, or by Indicament or Information in the King's Bench at Dublin, if fuch Offence be committed in Ireland; the Perfon fo convicted shall, for every Ar-tificer contracted with, or feduced, forfeit FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS, and shall fuffer Imprifonment in the Common Gcal of the County or Stewartry wherein such Offender shall be convicted. for Twelve Calendar Months, and until Forfeiture be paid : And in Cafe of a fubfequent .Offence of the fame Kind, the Persons so again offending thall forfeit, for every Perion contracted with of feduced, ONE THOUSAND POUNDS, and shall suffer Imprisonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convisted, for Two Years, and until fuch Forfeiture be paid.

If any Perfon in Great Britain or Ireland fhall put on Board any Ship or Boat, not bound directly to fome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, any fuch Tools or Utenfils as are commonly ufed in, or proper for the Preparing, Working up or Finifhing of the Woollen or Silk Manufactures or any Part of fuch Tools, he fhall, for every Offence, forfeit all fuch Tools, or Parts thereof, put on Board, and TWO HUNDRED POUNDS, to be recovered by Action of Debt, &c. in any Court of Record at Weftminfler, or in the Court of Seffion in Scotland, or at any of the Four Courts in Dublin refpectively, wherein no Effoin, &c. fhall be allowed.

It fhall be lawful for any Officer of the Cuftoms in Great Britain, or for any Officer of the Revenue in Ireland, to feize and fecure, in fome of His Ma-Cocket or Sufferance for the Shipping or Exporting of any of the faid Tools, or knowingly fuffer the fame to be done, he fhall forfeit ONE HUNDRED POUNDS, to be recovered as aforefaid, and alfo forfeit his Office, and be incapable of any Office under His Majefty.

One Moiety of the Forfeitures shall be applied to the Use of His Majesty, and the other Moiety to the Use of the Person who shall sue for the fame.
