The King has been pleased to grant unto William Henry Cavendish Bentinck, Esq; (commonly called Marquis of Titchfield) His Royal Licence and Authority that he and his Wife Henrietta (late Henrietta Scott) Daughter of the late Lieutenant-General John Scott, deceased, and their Issue, may assume and take the Surname and bear the Arms of Scott, in Addition to those of Bentinck; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds Office: And also to order that His Majesty's Concession and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms.
