And We do forthet promitr, thast any Perfon or Perlions concetred in luch Outtages as aforefaid, other than fuch as were aftually concered in any Aet by which Our Rayal Perfon was inmeduately endangered, wha hall give*

Information, fo as that any of fach Authors, Actors or Aberters as aforefidid thall be apprehended and braught to Juftice, ihall, upon Convietion of finch Offender or Offenders, reccive Dur mrod gracious Parlon.

WHEREAS ix hath been reprefented to Us, That, inmediately before the Opening of the prefent Seflion of Priliament, a great Number of Perfons were collected in Fieldgrin the Neighbourhood of the Metropotis, by Advertifements and Hand-Bills, and that divers inflammatory Difcourfon twere delivered to the Perfons fo collecked, and divers Proceedings were had, teading to create groundlefs Jealouly and Difcontent, and to endanger the Publick Peaces and the Quist and Safety of Our faithtul Subjects: And whereas it bath been alfo reprefented to $\mathrm{U}_{5}$. That divera feditiona and treafonable Papers have been Titely diltributed, tending to excite evil-difoled Perfons to Atts endangering Our Royal Perfon: And whereas fuch Proceedings have been followed, on the Day on which the preient Sefion of Parlizmenc commented, by Acts of Tumult and Violence, and by daring and bighly triminal Outrages, in direct Violation of the Pubick Peace, to the immediate Danger of $O$ Roy Roy Perfon, and to the Interruption of Our Paffage to and from Oar Parliament: And whereas grent Uncafinefs and Auriety bath been produced in the Minds of Our Eaithful Sulyjeets, dy Rumaurs and AppreThenfions that feçitions and anlawful Affemblies are inserded to he beld by evit-difpoled Perlons, and that fuch other crininal Pratices as axorefaid wre insended to be repeated: Wea therefore, have thonglat fit, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Councid, to enjoin and require, and We do hereby enjoin and require all Jultiecs of the Peaces. Sheriffs, Mayarg, Bailiffs, Conitables, and all other Our loving Subjefte thraughout Our Kingtome to ufe the utmot Diligence to difcourage, prevent, and fupprefs aid fectitious and uotawfol ABmblies: And We do fper cially unjoin and command all Our loving Subjeft, who Thall have Caule to fuped that any fucl Artemblies axe intended te be held int any Part of Our Eing dom, to give the tarlieft Information thereof tof
the Magitrates of the feveral Diftrict within which it fhall be fiupectrad that the fante are intended to be heldi and if fuch Affembies fhall, neverthelefs, in any Cafe, be adtudly beid, to be aiding and affifting, on being required therete by the Civil Magifirate, in caufing Perfons deljvering inflammators Difcourfes in fuch Alfemblies, and other principal Aftors therein, to be forthwith apprehended, in order that they may be dealt wirl according to Law. And We have alfo thought fit, by aud with the Advice aforefaid, to enjoin and tequire, and We do hereby enjoin and sequire all Jufices of the Peace. Sheriffs, Mayors, Bailutis, Conftabies, and all other Our Joving Subjects throughout Our King dom, to be in tike Manner eiding and affifing in bringing to Juftice all Perfons difribucing fuch feditious and trearonable Papers as aforeluid.

The KING's Moft Exceltent Majelty in Council.

WHEREAS by His Majefty ${ }^{5}$ Ordct in Council, bearing Dave the Thisteenth of March, 1793. an Ernbargo. wat laid on all Ships or Vertels laden or to be laden in ang of the Ports of Grear Britain, with Salted Provifions of any Kind whacfoever, and alfo upon all Ships and Veffels laden or to be Iaden with Burter and Cheefe, Peafe, Beans, Rice, Hay, Straw, or Forage of any Kind whafoever, and with Hides or Leather manufaßtured or ummanufactured; and it was ordered that che faid Embargo thould continue and remain upon att fuct Ships and Veffels until further Drder; but it was by the faid Ordex declared to he His Majenty's Pleasure, that the faid Enbargo thould not extend (amongit other Tiangs) to any Ships or Veftels, being Britifh Ships and Veflels, navigated ancording to Liaw, which may be employed in carrying any of the fait Articles abovementioned ta any Conntry in or onc of Earope, in Amity with His Majefly: And whereas His Majeity judges it expedient to prolibit the earrying any fuch Articles of Provifion $x s$ aforeflid to Countries in Arrity with His Majefty, it is hereby orđered, that notwithatanding any Thing in the faid Order of the Thisteenth of March, 1793 s contained to the contratys, the faid Embarga. fiall, from and after the Publitarian of this Order it the London Gapecter,

extend ed alf Ships and veifels wharifoever, laden or to be laden in any of the Ports of Great Britain with Salted Provifiont of any Kind whatfoever, or with Batter, Checfe, Hay, Straw or Porage of any Kind what foever, and which Ships or Veifels Ihall be tinployed in carrying any of the Articles above. mentioned to any Country in or out of Europe, in Amity with His Majefty. And the Right Honorable the Lords Commidioners of Hiv Majefty's Treafury, and the Lords Cummifionern of the Admiralty, are are so give the neceffary Directions hercin as to them may refpeqively appertain.

WHEREAS the Time limited by Hit Majefty's Order in Council of the 6th of Mas laft, probibiting the tranfporting into any Pasta out of this Kingdom any Pot-Afl or Pearl-Ah (except as in the faid Order is mentioned) will expice upon the 7th Day of wifs infant November: And whereay it is judged expedient that the faid $P$ rohibition fhould be continoed tor fanae Time longer; His Majelly doth therefore, with the Advice of Hia Privy Councit, hereby order, require, prohibit and command, thaz ne Perfon or Pations whatioever do, at any Time, during the Space of Six Manche from the 7th Day of this infant November, export, or attempt to export, cranfport, carry or conyey, or lade or Jay on Board of any Ship. Veffel or Boat, in order to the exported, trandported, carvied or conveyed out of this King dome any Pot-Ah or Pear-Afh, withdut Leave or Permifion being fith had and obtained from His Majefly or His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring the Fotfeitures inflicied by as AE pafled in the 「histy-fourth Yeer of His Majelly's Reigns intituled, "An Act for indemnifying all Perfons 4 who have been concerned in advifing or carrying " into Execution an Order af the Lords Commif. ** fionert of His Majefty's Treafury refpeaing the 4* Exportation of Pot-Alhes or Pearl-Ahth; for "4 preventidg Suits in confequence of the fame, af for authorizing His Majelly to probibic the Ex". portation or cartying Coatwife of Pot-Alter or af Pearl.aftes, and for making further Provifons "t relative therew." But it it nererithelefa His Majelty's Pleafare, that nothing herein contained fhall exrend, or be conltrued to extend, to provent the Exportation of the faid Ariclen to Ireland, or to His Majelfy's Illacde of Guerniey, Jerfey, Alderney, Satk or Mant or to Hin Majefly's Colonics or Plancations in America or the Weal Indites, or to New-
foundlond, ar to His Majelly's Forts and Settiemento on the Coaft of Africa, or to the 「Rand of St. Hew lena, or to the Britill Setticments or Fatzuries in the Eaff Indies ; provided that, upon the Exportation of the faid Articles to Ineland, or to His Majelly's Hlands of G uetrify, Jerfity, Alderney, Sark or Man, or to His Majerly's Colonite and Plantations in America or the Weit Jndies, or to the INand of Newfomalland, or to His Majelty's Forts and Settements on the Couth of Africa, or to the Jland of bt, Hetene, or the Britifh Settetnents or Fatoties in the Eafll Indies, the Expartery of the faid Articien do firt make Oath of the stue Dellination of the fame to the Places for which they flall be entered Outwands. before the Entry of the fame thall be mide, and do give foll and faficient Security, by Boxd, to the Satisfaction of the Comminionert of His Majraty'a Cuftoms, to carry the faid Articlea to the Places for which they art to entered Ootwards, and nane other; and fugh Bond thail not be cancelled or delivered up until Proof be made, to tie Saxisfaction of the Taid-Commilifioners, by the Produetion, whthin a Time to be fixed by the faid Commiftioners, und rpecified in the Bond, of a Certificate or Certifictet, in iveh Form and Manner an flatl be directed by the faid Commilioners, fhewing that the fidid Aricles have been duly landed at the Placet for which thay wers ontered Ounvards. And the Rigat Ifonorable the Lords Commifionera of His Majefty's Treafury, the Commifionery for ezecuting the Office of Lord High Admiral of Grear Bricsity, end the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the necefiry Directions herein, as to thent may refpectively appertaio.

WHEREAS His Majefty was gracioulfy pleafed, by HisR Ryal Prociamation bearing Date the Twenty-Exth Day of Dectmber, 1797, to promifeand declare, that the Boonties of Fire Pound, for every Able Seamen, and Two Poondi Ten Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, fit for His Majefly's Service, fhoold be paid in the Mander thereby direted to every fuch Able and Ordianry Seaman, not above the Age of Fifiy nor under the Age of Twentry Yearn, who fhould, on or before the Twenty-eighth Day of Pebruary thes following, enter themfetves to ferve in His Majelty's Royal Navy, either with the Captains or Liteutenants of His Majefly'i Shipe or Vcseds. or Officers employed on Shore for railing Men for the

Scrvice of the Rogal Navy: And whereas $H$ is Majelly was atfo graciodly pleafed, by His faid Proclanution, to declare, that all Able-bodied Landmen, fot above the Age of Thirty-Give nor under the Age of Twenty Years, who Ghoald fo conter theanflues as aforelaid, fhould receive the Sum of Thirty Shillings each Man, as His Majefty's Royal Boynty: And whereas His Majelty was alio graciouily plealed, by I-is Royal Proclamation bearing Date the Sixteenth Day of the faid wionth of February, 1793 , to promite and declare, that a Reward of Twenty Shilliggs for cvery Able and Ordinary Scanian, fit to ferve on board His Majerty's Ships, iloould be paid to any Pcrion who fhould difeover any Semman or Seamen who might conceal him or thernfelves, fo that fich Seaman or Seamen fhould be taken for His Mijelly's Service, on or before tise Thistetin Day of April then texit, by any of Ris Majelty's Sea Oithicers appointed to raife Men on Shore, or by the Captains or Commanders etif any of His Majelly's bhips or Veflels in the Perts or on che Coalts of this Kingdorn: And whereas the Time dimied by the faid Proclamations for Pryment of the faid Bounties and Reward, lath been prolonged and excended to the Thirty firit Day of this initant $O E$ golaer; and it being judged expe dient for Han Majely's Service that the fiaid Buunties and keward frould be concinued to be paid for fome Time langer; His Majelty, with tiae Advice of His Privy Council, doth therefore order, and it is hesely actordingly-ordejed, that the Time limited for Payment of the faid Bonnties and Rewa;d be prolonged and extended, from the faid 'Tbircy-Gra Day of this isitant Otuber to the 'I bis. ey-firll Dily of December next inelufive: Whereof all Pcrlions concerned are to take Nolice, and govan themfelves accordiugly.
