W Hereas Richard Lee, late of the Strand, in the County of Middlefex, Bookfeller, Itaniis indicted for publishing a traiterous and feditious Libel intitled "King Killing," and allo for publishing 'Iwo other traiterous and feditious Libels, and being apprehended and conveyed, by Lord Chief Justice Kenyon's Tipstaff, to the House of Thomas Wright, One of the Officers of the Sneriff of Middlefex, for saie Cuftody until he should find Sureties to answer the faid Indictments or be committed to Prifon, efcaped out of fuch Cullody on the Evening of Wed. neiday the 9th Day of this Inflant December: The Lords Committioners of His Majefty's Treafury, in order that the faid Richard Lee may be brought to Justice for the Offences whereof he is indicted, are hereby pleafed to offer a Reward of ONE HUN-DRED POUNDS to any Perion who thall diffeover the faid Richard Lee, fo that he may be retaken and committed, and dealt with according to Law. The faid Richard Lee is a very young Man, of a boyifh Appearance, about Five Feet Seven Inches high, wears his own Hair in his Neck, is of a pale Complexion, thin Vifage, and very flender.

TTTHereas it has been humbly represented to the King, that on the Night of the 29th, or early in the Morning of the 3010 Ultimo, a barbarous and inhuman Murder was committed on the Body of Thomas Nevell, a private Soldier in the North York Regiment of Militia, near the Barracks, & Tynemouth, in the County of Northumberland, and that all Endeavours to differver the Perfon or Perflus who committed the faid Murder, bave bitberto proved ineffectual.
