

Downing-Street, August 13, 1796. N Explanatory Article to the Treaty of Amity, Commerce and Navigation, between His Majefty and the United States of America, was concluded and figned, at Philadelphia, on the 4th Day of May laft, by Phineas Bond, Efq; on the Part of His M. jefty, and by Timothy Pickering, Efq; on the Part of the United States; and the fame has been duly ratified by the Two Contracting Parties.

Extract of a Letter from Admiral Sir Pcter Parker, Bart. Commonder in Chief of His Majefty's Ships and Veffeis at Portfmouth and Spithead, to Mr. Nepean, dated Royal William, at Spithead, August 6, 1796,

THE Telemachus Cutter returned this Morning from a Cruize, with the Marguarita French Privateer of Four Guns and Forty Mcn., which the cap-tured Yetterday Afternoon off the Owers: The faid Privateer had, early the fame Morning, taken the Sloop John, William Ayles, Matter, from Sunder-land, bound to Weymouth, which the Telemachus retook and fent into this Port. Inclosed is Lieutenant Crispo's Letter, giving an Account of the Capture and Recapture above mentioned.

Telemachus, at Spithead, August 6, 1796.

I HAVE the Honor to acquaint you, that Yefter-day Morning, being off the Needles, I flood in Shore after a Sloop and Cutter ; foon after the Cutter made Sail to the Eaftward, and at Eleven coming up with the Sloop, recaptured the John, of Weymouth, William Ayles, Master, loaded with Coals, who had been taken in the Morning early by the Cutter. After making all poffible Difpatch in taking Charge of her, I immediately gave Chace to the

Cutter, which had got at a great Distance; but the fast failing of the Telemachus brought us up with her at a Quarter pail Two in the Afternoon, being then off the Owers, when firing a Shot at her, the ftruck, and proved to be the Marguarita, French Cutter Privateer, mounting Four Guns and Four Swivels, and manned with Forty Men. She had been Three Days from Cherbourg, and had only taken this Sloop; but I have the Satisfaction to add, that by taking her, Five other Veffels efcaped being captured.
