T is this Day o dered by His Majesty, by and with the Advice of his Privy Council, that an Order, made at this Board on the Third Day of September last, granting Licence, notwithstanding certain Acts paffed in the Thirty-third and Thirtyfourth Years of His Majesty's Reign, and therein mentioned, to pay, fend, fupply, or deliver, or caufe to be paid, fent, fupplied, or delivered, either by Payment or Remittance, of any Bill of Exchange, Note, Draught, Obligation, or Order for Money, or in any other Manner whatfoever, any Money, to or for the Ufe of any Perfon or Perfons refiding or being in any Part or Place of the United Provinces, the Auftrian Netherlands, or Italy, or in any Town or Place in Germany, and to do divers other Acts, in the faid Order particularly mentioned : And the Licence thereby given, and every Part thereof, be revoked and difcharged; and the faid Order, and the Licence thereby given, and every Part thereof, are hereby revoked and discharged. And all Persons are to take Notice of His Majefty's Pleafure hereby fignified, and govern themfelves accordingly.

October 1, 2796. H IS Majefty doth hereby direct and require, that all the OUT-PENSIONERS of CHELSEA-HOSPITAL, refiding in South Britain, who were difcharged from their refpective Corps as

Corporals or Private Men (those refident in London, or within Twenty-five Miles theteof, who are to attend at Chelsea on such Days as the Commissioners of the faid Hospital shall appoint; the Out-Penfioners from the Cavalry; those Men also who by the Hospital Books are now more than Fifty-five Years of Age, or had ferved Twenty-five Years in the Army previously to their Discharges; and those who have lost an Eye or a Limb, excepted) do perfonally appear at the Places, and on the Days, hereinafter mentioned; that such of them, as on Examination shall be found fit, may be fent to Garrison Duty only, viz.

Kent and Surrey, (more than 25 Miles from London) —Maidftone, 24th and 25th October; or Winchefter 4th and 5th November.

Suffex-Lewes; 29th and 31st October; or Winchefter, 4th and 5th November.

Hampfhire-Wincheiter, 4th and 5th November.

- Berk/bire and Oxford/bire-Oxford, 8th and 9th No. vember.
- Somerjetshire-Bridgwater, 24th and 25th October; or Briftol, 28th and 29th October.

Wiltshire-Devizes, 1st and 2d November.

Dorfetshire-Blandford, 5th and 7th November.

- Devonshire—Exeter or Launceston, 24th and 25th October; or Barnstaple, 29th and 31st October.
- Cornwall-Launcefton, 24th and 25th October; or Truro, 29th and 31ft October.
- Gloucesterschire and Worcesterschire-Gloucester, 24th and 25th October; or Bristol, 28th and 29th October; or Birmingham, 29th and 31st October, and 1st November.
