otherwise, by His Majesty's Commissioners for exe- | for their Gustaince herein; as also another Draught cuting the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, shall and may lawfully seize all Ships, Vessels and Goods belonging to the King of Spain, or his Subjects, or others inhabiting within the Territories of the King of Spain, and bring the fame to Judgment in any of the Courts of Admiralty within His Majesty's Dominions; and to that End His Majesty's Advocate-General, with the Advocate of the Admiralty, are forthwith to prepare the Draught of a Commission, and present the same to His Majesty at this Board, authorizing the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord-High Admiral, or any Person or Persons by them empowered and appointed, to iffue forth and grant Letters of Marque and Reprizals, to any of His Majesty's Subjects, or others whom the faid Commissioners shall deem fitly qualified in that Behalf, for the apprehending, feizing and taking the Ships, Veffels and Goods belonging to Spain, and the Vaffals and Subjects of the King of Spain, or any inhabiting within his Countries, Territories or Dominions; and that fuch Powers and Clauses be inserted in the said Commission as have been usual, and are according to former Precedents. And His Majesty's faid Advocate-General, with the Advocate of the Admiralty, are also forthwith to prepare the Draught of a Commission, and present the same to His Majesty at this Board, authorizing the faid Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, to will and require the High Court of Admiralty of Great Britain, and the Lieutenant and Judge of the faid Court, his Surrogate or Surrogates, as also the feveral Courts of Admiralty within His Majesty's Dominions, to take Cognizance of, and judicially proceed upon, all and all Manner of Captures, Seizures, Prizes and Reprizals of all Ships and Goods that are or shall be taken, and to hear and determine the same; and, according to the Course of Admiralty and the Laws of Nations, to adjudge and condemn all such Ships, Vessels and Goods as shall belong to Spain, or the Vassals and Subjects of the King of Spain, or to any others inhabiting within any of His Countries, Territories and Dominions; and that fuch Powers and Chauses be inferted in the faid Commission as have been usual and are according to former Precedents; and they are likewise to prepare and lay before His Majesty, at this Board, a Draught of such Instructions as may Be proper to be sent to the Courts of Admiralty in His Majesty's Foreign Governments and Plantations

of Instructions for such Ships as shall be commisfionated for the Purposes aforementioned.
