"Council." But it is, nevertheless, His Majesty's Pleasure, that nothing herein contained shall extend, or be construed to extend, to any of His Majesty's Ships of War, or any other Ships or Vessels or Boats, in the Service of His Majetty, or employed or freighted by His Majetty's Board of Ordnance, or by the Commissioners of His Ma jelly's Navy; nor to prevent any Ship or Veffel from taking or having on Board tuch Quantities of Naval Stores as may be necessary for the Use of such Ship or Vessel during the Course of her intended Voyage, or by Licence from the Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, or the Commissioners of the Admiralty for the Time being; nor to the Ex portation of the faid several Articles to Ireland, or to His Majesty's Yards or Garrisons, or to His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations in America or the Welt Indies, or to Newfoundland, or to His Majesty's Forts and Settlements on the Coast of Africa, or to the Island of St. Helena, or to the British Settlements or Factories in the East Indies; provided that, upon the Exportation of any of the faid Articles, for the Purposes of Trade, to Ireland, or to His Majesty's Yards or Garrisons, or to His Majesty's Colonies and Plantations in America or the West Indies, or to the Island of Newfoundland, or to His Majesty's Forts and Settle-ments on the Coast of Africa, or to the Island of St. Helena, or the British Settlements or Factories in the East Indies, the Exporters of such Articles do first make Oath of the true Destination of the fame to the Places for which they shall be entered Outwards, before the Entry of the same shall be made, and do give full and fufficient Security by Bond, to the Satisfaction of the Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs, to carry the said Articles to the Places for which they are fo entere dOutwards, and for the Purpoles specified, and none other; and such Bond shall not be cancelled or delivered up, until Proof be made, to the Satisfaction of the faid Commissioners, by the Production, within a Time to be fixed by the faid Commifsioners, and specified in the Bond, of a Certificate or Certificates, in such Form and Manner as shall be directed by the faid Commissioners, shewing that the faid Articles have been duly landed at the Places for which they were entered Outwards. And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, and the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the necessary Directions herein, as to them may respectively appertain.
