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Chirurgeon, Pilot, and Chaplain on Board, finall have One Eightb Part, to be equally dividea amongf them:
The Midfhipmen, Captain's Clefk, Mafter Sailmaker, Carpenter's Mates, Boartiwain's Mates, Gunner's Mates, Maiter at Arms, Corporals, Yeomen of the Sheers, Cockfyain, Quarter Marters, Quarter Mafters Mates, Chirurgeon's Mates, Ycomen of the Powder Room, Serjeants of Marines, and Land Forces on Board, Alall have One Eights Part, to be equally divided amongt them:
The Trumpeters, Quarter Gunnets, Carpenter's Crew, Steiwards, Cook, Armourer, Stewara's Mate, Cook's Mate, Gunfmith, Coôper, Swabber, Ordinary Trumpeter, Barber, Able Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and Marines and other Soldiers, and all other Perfons doing Duty and affifing on Board, fhall have Two Eights Parts, to be equally divided amongit them:
Provided, That if any Officer being on Board any of Our Ships of War, at the Timie of taking any Prize, fhall have more Commiffions or Ofices than One, fuch Offcer fhall be intided only to the Share or Shares of the Prizes which, according to the above-mentioned Diltribution, flall belong to his Superior Comnifition or Ofice. And We do hereby frictly enjoin all Commanders of Our Ships and Veffels of War taking any Prize, as foon as may be, to tranfmit, or cause to be tranfmitted, to the Corimiffioners of Our Navy, a true Lift of the Names of all the Officers, Seamen, Maxines, Soldjers, and others, who were actually on Board Our Ships and Vefiels of War under their Command at the Time of the Capture; which Lift thall contain the Quality of the Service of each Perfon on Board, and be fub: fribed by the Captain or Commanding Officer, and Three or more of the Chief Officers on Board. And We do hereby require and diret the Commiffioners of Our Navy, or any Thrte or more of them, to examine or caufe to be examinined, fuch Litts by the Mufter Books of fuch Ships and Veffels of War, and Lifts annexed thereto, to fee that fuch Lifts do agree with the faid Multer Books and annexed Lifts, as to the Names, Qualities, or Ratings, of the Officers, Seamen, Marines, Soldiers, and others belonging to fuch Ships and Veffels of War, and upon Requeft forthwith to grant a Certificate of the Truth of any Litt tranfmitted to them, to the Agents nominated and appointed by the Captors to take care and difpofe of fuch Prize; and alfo upon Application to them (the faid Commiffioners) they fall give, or caufe to be given, to the faid Agents, all fuch Lifts from the Muutter Books of any fuch Ships of War, and annexed Lifts, as the faid Ageuts fhall find requifite for their Direction in paying the Produce of fich Prizes, and otherwife fhall be aiding and affiting to the faid Agents in all fuch Matters as fhall be neceffary. We do hereby further will and direet, that the following Regulations fhall be obferved concerning the One Eightb Part herein-before mentioned to be granted to the Flag or Flag Officcrs, who fhall actually be oa Board at the taking of any Prize, or fhall be directing or affifting theiein: Firft, That a Flag Officer, Commander in Chief, when there is but One Flag Officer upon Service, flall have to his own Ufe the fraid One Eighth Part of the Prizes taken by Ships and Vefiels under his Command: Secondly, That a Flag Officer, fent to command ai Jainaica,
or elfewhere, fhall have no Right to any Share of Prizes taken by Ships or Veffels employed there, before he arrives at the Place to which he is fent, and actualyl takes upon him ithe Command: Thirdy, That when an inferior Flag Officer is fent out to reinforce a fuperior Flag Officer at Jamaica, or elfewhere, the fuperior Flag Oficer flall have no Right to any Share of Prizes taken by the inferior Flag Officer before the inferior Flag Officer fhall arrive within the Limits of the Command of the fuperior Flag Officer, ànd actually receive fome Order from him: Fourthly, That a Chief Flag Officer returning Home from Jamaica, or elfewhere, fhall have no Share of the Prizes taken by the Ships or Vefiels left behind to ãit under another Command: Fifity, That if a Flag Officer is fent to command in the Out-Ports of this Kingdom, he Thall have no Share of the Prizes taken by Ships or Vefiels which have failed from that Port by Order frofin the Admiraity: Sixthly, That when more Flag Officers than One ferve together, the Eighth Part of the Prizes taken by any Ships or Veffels of the Fleet or Squadron, fhall be divided in the following Proportions, viz. If there be buc Two Flag Officers, the Chief thall have T.wo Tbird Parts of the faid One Eighth Part, and the other thall have the remaining Third Part; but if, the Number of Flag Officers be more than Two, the Chief fhall bave only One Half, and the other Half fhall be epually divided amonglt the other Flag Officers: Seventhly, That Commodores, with Captains under them, fhall be efteemed as Flag Officers with refpect to the Eighth Part of Prizes taken, whether commanding in Chief, or fiving under Command: Eighthly, That the Firft Captain to thie Admiral and Commander in Chief of Our Fleet, and alfo the Firf Captain to Our Flag Of. cer appointed, or. hereafter to be appointed, to command a Fleet or Squadron of Twenty Ships of the Line of Battle, and alfo the Firft Captain to Our Flag Officer appointed, or hereafter to be appointed, to command a Fleet or Squadron of Fifteen Ships of the Line of Battle (provided fuch laft mentioned Fieet or Squadron fhall be compofed of His Majefty's own Ships,) fhall be deemed and taken to be a Flag Officer, and fhall be entitled to a Part or Share of Prizes as the junior Flag Officer of fuch Fleet or Squadron. And We do hereby further Order, That in cafe of Cutters, Schooners, and other armed Verfels cominanded by Lieutenanis, the Share of fuch Lieutenants fhall be Three Eighth Parts of the Prize, unlefs fuch Lieutenants fhall be under the Command of a Flag Officer or Officers; in which Cafe the Flag Oficer or Officers fhall have One of the faid THbree Eightbs, to be divided among fuch Flag Ofiçer or Officers in the Manner herein before directed in the Cafe of Captains ferving under Flag Oficers: Secondly, We direat that the Slaare of the Mafter, or other Perfon acting as Second in Conmand, and the Filot (if there happens to be One on Board) hall be One Eightb Part, to be divided into Three equal Parts, of which Two Tbirds fall go to the Mafter or other Perfon acting as Second in Command, and the remaining One Thbird to the Pilot; but if there is no Pilot, then fuch Eighth Part to go wholly to the Maftes or Perfon acting as Second in Command: That the Share of the Chirurgeon or Chirurgeon's Mate (where there is no Chirurgeon) Midnipmen, and Clerk and Steward, flall be One Eighto; that the Share of the Boaifivain's, Gumer's and Car,
