

Extract of a Letter from the Hon. Robert Stopford, Commander of H11 Majesty's Ship Phaeton, to Evan Nepean, Ejq; date dat Falmouth, the 9th of March, 1797.

I Have to request you will inform their Lordships, that, on the 6th Instant, Ushant bearing E. by W. Forty-fix Leagues, I captured a French Privateer called L'Actif, a Ship carrying Eighteen Guns and 120 Men; she failed from Nantes on the 16th Ult. and, on the 27th Ult. captured the Princefs Elizabeth Packet coming from Jamaica, in Lat. 40 Deg. 30 Min. Long. 14 Deg. 30 Min. the only English Prize fhe had made during her Cruize. Several Privateers were fitting at Nantes at the Time that the Actif failed.
