Manner, and under fuch Terms and Reftrictions, as His Majefty shall think fit :--And whereas the faid Lords Commissioners have represented to His Majesty, That it appears to them that the Crews of the of the Ships herein after mentioned; that is to fay, the Sandwich, Montagu, Director, Inflexible, Monmouth, Belliqueux, Standard, Lion, Naffau, Repulse, Grampus, Proferpine, Brilliant, Tyliphone, Iris, Champion, Comet, Pylades, Swan and Infpector, have been guilty of Acts of Mutiny and Rebellion, particularly by taking the Command of the faid Ships from His Majefty's Officers, by combining to obstruct the Trade and Navigation of the Port of London, and by other Acts of the most heinous Nature, and that fome of fuch Crews had actually fired on divers of His Majesty's Ships, and that all the faid Crews still perfisted in fuch their Mutiny and Rebellion.

His Majefty, in purfuance of the Powers vested in Him by the above recited Act, is hereby pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to authorize, and by this His Order in Council doth authorize the faid Commissioners for Executing the Office of Lord High Admiral, or any Three or more of them, to declare the Crews of the faid Ships to be in a State of Mutiny and Rebellion, and to warn all His Majefty's faithful Subjects to abitain from all Communication or Intercourfe with the Crews of the faid Ships, in the Manner directed by the faid Act.

And His Majesty is hereby further pleased, with the Advice aforefaid, to authorize and require the faid Commiffioners, or any Three or more of them, to accept the Submission of the Crew of any of the faid Ships, or of

feitures in the faid A& contained, in fuch | any Perfon or Perfons, Part of fuch Crew, or of any Perlon or Perlons on Board of any of the faid Ships; or to declare any fuch Perfon or Perfons to have returned to their Duty; and thereupon to declare the Perlons or Perfon, whole Submiffion shall be to accepted, or who thall be declared to have returned to their Duty, to be exempted and relieved from all or any of the Penalties and Forfeitures in the faid Act contained, in fuch Manner and under fuch Terms and Reftrictions as His Majefty shall think fit.
