Downing-Street, June 9, 1797.

A Messenger arrived Yesterday at Lord Grenville's Office from Sir Charles Whitworth, K. B. His Majesty's Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary at the Court of Petersburg, with His Imperial Majesty's Ratification of the Treaty of Commerce concluded between His Majesty and the Emperor of Russia.

The Ratifications were exchanged at Moscow on the 17th Ultimo.
