IN consequence of an Address of both Houses of Parliament, presented to His Majesty on Thursday last, requesting that His Majesty would be graciously pleased to give Directions for carrying into Execution certain Resolutions agreed to by both Houses of Parliament, for the more speedy and general Promulgation of the Statutes of the Realm, His Majesty has been pleased to give Directions accordingly, that Copies of all Statutes, as well Public as Private, which shall hereafter be enacted, shall forthwith be distributed, according to the Tenor of the said Resolutions, to the several Courts of Justice, Magistrates, and other Persons and Places therein enumerated, whereof the following is a Transcript.
