I am sorry to say we could only save Seventeen, and them owing to the Perseverance of my Senior Lieutenant Mr. Palmier, and a few Seamen, in the Launch. She proved to be La Cornelle French Privateer Brig, of Nantz, mounting 12 Guns, and 90 Men; had been out Sixteen Days, and only captured a Danish Ship.
