WHEREAS His Majesty's Writs have been issued for calling a Parliament to meet and to be holden at the City of Dublin; the Meeting of which Parliament hath been, by His Majesty's Command, prorogued to Tuesday the Twenty-first Day of November instant: And whereas His Majesty hath signified His Royal Pleasure, that the Meeting of the said Parliament be further prorogued to Tuesday the Ninth Day of January next, 1798, then to sit for the Dispatch of Business: We do therefore publish and declare, that the Meeting of the said Parliament be, and the Meeting of the said Parliament is hereby further prorogued to Tuesday the Ninth Day of January next, 1798, and the same shall be then held at Dublin, and sit for the Dispatch of Business; whereof the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens and Burgesses, are to take Notice and give their Attendance accordingly:
