*Westminster, January 12, 1798.*

**T**HIS Day the Lords Being met, a Message was sent to the Honourable House of Commons by Mr. Quarme, the Yeoman Usher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that *The Lords, authorized by virtue of His Majesty's Commission for declaring His Royal Assent to several Acts agreed upon by both Houses, do desire the immediate Attendance of this Honourable House in the House of Peers, to hear the Commission read; and the Commons being come thither; the said Commission, empowering the Lord Archbishop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and several other Lords therein named, to declare and notify the Royal Assent to the said Acts, was read accordingly, and the Royal Assent given to*

An Act for granting to His Majesty an Aid and Contribution for the Prosecution of the War.

An Act for allowing, during the Continuance of the present War, a certain Proportion of the Men, raised in pursuance of Two Acts of the last Session of Parliament for augmenting the Militia, to enlist into His Majesty's other Forces, and to serve until Six Months after the Conclusion of a General Peace.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers of Two several Acts, one passed in the Twenty-fourth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, and the other in the Sixteenth Year of His present Majesty, so far as the same relate to repairing the Road from Tadcaster to Halton Dyal, in the West Riding of the County of York.

And to Seven Private Bills.

The King has been pleased to grant unto George-Arnold Arnold, of Halsted Place in the County of Kent, Esq; His Royal Licence and Authority, that Henry Arnold, a Minor, his Second Son by Mary-Anne his Wife, (the Daughter of James Haughton-Langston, late of Bedford-Square in the County of Middlesex, Esq; deceased, and Niece of Harry Haughton, late of Queen's Square in the Parish of St. George the Martyr, in the said County of Middlesex, Esq; deceased) and his Issue,

may, in Compliance with an Injunction contained in the last Will and Testament of the said Harry Haughton, take and use the Surname, and bear the Arms of Haughton only; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds Office.

The King has also been pleased to grant unto William Hall, of Pinkney in the Parish of Tratterfett in the County of Norfolk, Esq; His Royal Licence and Authority, that he, and his Issue, may (out of grateful Respect to the Memory of his reputed Father, John Hall, late of Pinkney aforesaid, Gentleman, deceased) take and use the Surname of Hall:

And also to order that these His Majesty's Concessions and Declarations be registered in His College of Arms.

*Whitehall, January 12, 1798:*

The King has been pleased to present the Reverend Thomas Pettat, Master of Arts, to the Vicarage of Stonehouse in the County and Diocese of Gloucester, void by the Resignation of the Reverend John Pettat, late Incumbent thereof.

The King has also been pleased to present the Reverend Henry Fitz-Roy, (commonly called Lord Henry Fitz-Roy) Master of Arts, to the Rectory of Toppesfield, in the County of Essex and Diocese of London, void by the Death of the Reverend George Pawson, late Incumbent thereof.
