Bruffels, Fuly 7. Yesterday arrived an Express from Paris, bringing Letters from the Marquis de los Balbaces to his Excellency, in which he gives an. account of the Marriage between the King of Spainand Madamoiselle d' Orleans being declared, and that he was going to fign the Articles of Marriage, which news has occasioned great rejoicing here. Our Letters from Nimeguen inform us that the Imperial and French Ambassadors were finally come to an Agreement about executing the Peace, the Emperor having co finted to draw his Troops out of the Empire and to quit the places, he has at present Garrisons in, upon which the French will do the like. From the Hague they tell us, that the prefling Instances of the French Ambassador in behalf of the Count of Benthem, are like to prevail with the States, to reffore that Count's Children, which they
