The Queen of Spain having paft four or hve days here, went yesterday with her Father the Duke of Orleans to St. Clou, from whence her Marchy will return hither on Monday pext; and then go back to finitainbleau, in order to her beginning her journy for Spain. In our lalt we gave you an account that the Peace between this Crown, Susday, and Demark, was figned on Sunday laft; we are told that by it the King of Demark, obliges himfelf to refore all he has taken during, this War, as well in Schonen, as elfewhore; That the Duke of Holftein Goutorp is to he re-clashilled in his Countries, and acknowledged Soveraign of the Gau-

try of Slewick, according to the Treaty c nelud d at Copenhagen, 1662. And that the King of Su.d.n., even before the Exchange of the Ratification and this Treaty, may transport his Troops to Sermany, to Gasilon the places in Romeren and Bremen, that are to be reflored to him by the Elector of Brandenburg, and the Princes of Lunenburg.
