It is raid he wib propofe a Marriage between she Elettor and the Emperors Daughter, or at teafte endeavor to prevent that Eledors marrying with a French Lady. What was faid of Chancellor smidt, and otber of the Ele: ctors Officorswho arc lookt upon to be favouress of the "Ftench fintereds, beiag difgraced, is aty confirned.
Prague, Nev. 4* This Court is much alarmed at the news a Courier fent by the Duke of Lorrem brought them, which is, that, the Frence ternand '7oo thougand, Fiorins of the Colntry of Brifgow, four whereof they pretend to be due before the Peace, and three fiace ; a Sum that Country is iniss prefent ruin'd condition altogether unable to pay. We are told that the Emperor has refolved in the prefint poiture of affairs, not to intermedde in thismiteer, and to leave the Country to make the deft comperition it can ; but in the meas tine nioft people are of opinion that if the French proceed after ethis fnathmer the Peace cannot lalt tong.

- Ratidibonne, Niov. 7. On Friday laft aerived here the Marquis $4 e V$ itry Envoy Extraordinary from the Moft Chriftiat King to the Emperor, and the next clay continued his jourmy, intending to pafs through mazumian. The fame day cane thither Count Lobcowits, from Prague, who underitanding that Mont fieur Co'bert the French Ambaffador was arrived at Muncken, the Electiot of Bavaria's Court, imtredintely haffetied his joumy thither.

Strasturg, Nov. Io. The French have lately changed cueir Garifons in Lutzelftein, Lichrenberg, and Dacbsburg ; and it's faid they ineend to quit atd raze the two latter; While they work every day harder and harder on the Fortifications of $\mathrm{Hu} \%$ *i/gen, 'Scblejkadt, Bitfch, and Homburg, andreciive great Sunis of Miony frima France for the encou rigement of that Work Several p. rions of gua lity have lately paffed through this City on their way fiom France to the C urt of Bavaria, where the Marriage ortwe n the D:uphin a.d that Electors Siler is treating, and as every body believes is as goot as concluded. The French that pals through bere $\mathrm{fan}_{\mathrm{s}}$, the Dauphin will come as far as Na h c y to meet his Bite, and that he will refide there, the king giving him the Government of Lorrain, Alface and Burgundy.
Breffels, Nov. 14. The States of Brabanz cannot hitherto be prevailed with to grant the 1200 thoufand Florins which his Excellency has demandcid of them, and it's faid they defer taking a final Refolution therein till they fee whether any lupplies come from Spain, without which, they think the Monies thefe Provinces can raife will fignifie little. The Letrets from Liege give a large defcription of the nifery of that Country, that many Villages are wholly deferted of Inhabitints, and that more will be, in eafe the French winter there, as according to all appeararce their intention is; ar the fame time the Elector of Cologne has fent fome of his Guards to quarter in the Dildicht of Franchinabxt, to oblige thofe Inhabitants to pay the Arrears of Conttibutiuns due to the Imperialifits, which his Electoral Highnefs was fored to make good to them before they quitted Bonne. Frum Cologne thcy write, that the French are fo far from leaviag that Diocefs, that they have fummoned the Inhabitants to bring in to their feveral Garifons, which they augment daily, great quantities of Forage and Wood. Monfieur Colbert the French Ambaffador is arrived at the Court of baviaria, whither the Emparor has likewife fent Count Lobcowits; we fhall quickly fee which of the two will be the mofl fuccelsful, though people here generally b. lieve the French Interefts will prevail, and chatthe Marriage between the Dauphin and the Princefs of Bavaria will be concluded.

Hague, Nov. 17. The States of Holland arenow fummoned to meet on the $22^{\circ}$ inftant, againft which time the Prince of orayge is expected here. The Duke of Monmouth has fpent feveral days with his Highnefs at Diereh and at Soeftike, and when his Highnefs comes hither, his Grace goes back to Zarecbt. The Actions of the Eaft India Company, which within thefe few days fell frim 3 so to 330 , are new come up agail to 335. The French give out that at the meeting of the States of Holland an Alliance between this State and Frasce will be piopofed, which a few days will how;

Thimouth, Nov. 71 Yefterday His Majefties Ship the stoal:oto, Captain Fowler Commander, came into this Pork with the reft of the Merchant Ships

Tork, Nov. 8. On Thurfday in the evening their Royal Highneffes came hither, having been received at their entring into this County by the High-Sheriff, and many of the Nobility and orher perfons of quality, and met by feveral others on the Road. Four miles from hence our Sheriffs met ct:eir Royal Highneffes, and waited upon them hither. Upon their arrival they were faluted with 21 great Cuns ftum the Calle; the Trained uands were in Arms to pay th.ir refpeets to them; and our Lord Maycr was to nait upon their Royal Highneffes at their Lodging. This day our Archbilhop has invited his Koyal Highnees to Dinnur, (his Houfe being three milesfrom hence) whither a great many perfons of quality are preparing to attend him. On Monday their Royal Highnefles part hence again; will lie that night at Rippoz, on Tuefday at Ricimond, and on Wednefday at Durbam.

Eondon, Nov. Io.
