

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers of Two Acts, of the Second and Twenty-second Years of His present Majesty, for amending and widening the Road leading from Colley Gate, in Cradley, and from Pedmore to Holly Hall, and other Roads therein mentioned, in the Counties of Worcester, Stafford, and Salop, so far as the same relate to the Road leading from Pedmore to Holly Hall; and for repairing several other Roads in the Counties of Worcester and Stafford.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, the Term, and enlarging the Powers of Two several Acts, the One passed in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, the other in the Eighteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for amending and keeping in Repair the Roads leading from a Place called Fryer Bacon's Study to Chilton Pond, and from the Top of Hinksey Hill to Foxcombe Hill Gate, in the Road leading to Farringdon in the County of Berks; so far as the same relate to the Abingdon District of the said Roads, therein mentioned.

An Act for enlarging the Powers of, and rendering more effectual, several Acts, of the Twenty-fourth and Twenty-eighth Years of His late Majesty's Reign, and of the Fourth and Twenty-ninth Years of His present Majesty's Reign, for repairing the High Roads in the County of Edinburgh, and for building Bridges over the Rivers South and North Esk, and the Water of Leith, in the said County.
