THE King has been pleased to grant unto Lieutenant-Colonel George Charles Brathwaite, of Great Portland-Street, in the County of Middlesex, (only Son of Major-General John Brathwaite,) His Royal Licence and Authority, that he and Eliza his now Wife, and their Issue, may take and use the Surname of Boughton, and bear the Arms of Boughton, with proper Distinctions; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Herald's-Office; and to order that His Majesty's said Concession and Declaration be registered in his College of Arms.
