SIR, EREWITH you will receive a Copy of a Letter from Sir Edward Pellew, of His Majefty's Ship Indefatigable, addreffed to Vice-Admiral Sir Alan Gardner, flating the Capture of the French National Corvette La Vaillante.

BRIDPORT.

Indefatigable at Sea, August 8, 1798.

SIR, I Have great Pleafure in communicating to you the Capture of the French National Corvette La Vaillante, commanded by the Lieutenant de Vaillante, commanded by the Lieutenant de Vaillante, pierced for Twenty-two, and manned with One Hundred and Seventy-five Men. This Ship failed from Rochefort the 1ft, and

from L'Isle de Rhé the 4th Instant, with Twenty-five banished Priests, Twenty-feven Convicts, and Madame Rovere and Family, for Cayenne. We fell in with her at Day-break on the 7th, between Bourdeaux and the Isle of Rhé, and the Chace continued Twenty-four Hours, when the ftruck after firing a few Guns. She is of large Dimenfions, only Eighteen Months old, Coppered and Copper fastened, fails fast, and will, I truft, be found fit for His Majefty's Service.
