

One Moiety of the Forfeitures shall be applied to the Use of His Majesty, and the other Moiety to the Use of the Person who shall sue for the same.

*Statutes 14, 21, 25, and 26 of His present Majesty.*

BY these Statutes the like Penalties and Forfeitures as above-mentioned are extended to Persons packing or putting on board any Vessel, not bound directly for some Port in Great Britain or Ireland, any Machine, Engine, Tool, Press, Paper, Utensil, or Implement whatsoever, used in or proper for the working or finishing of the Cotton, Steel, or Iron Manufactures of this Kingdom, or any Part or Parts of such Machines or Implements, or any Models or Plans thereof; and all Captains of Ships and other Persons receiving or being in Possession of any such Articles, with an Intent to export the same to Foreign Parts, and all Custom-house Officers suffering an Entry to be made thereof, are respectively liable to the like Penalties as are above-mentioned, in the case of Tools and Utensils used in the Woollen and Silk Manufactures.

Notice is hereby given, that Application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session for Leave to bring in a Bill for making certain Rail-Ways or Roads, Wharfs, and such other Works as may be thought necessary for the Conveyance of Coal, Lime, &c. from the Mines of Henry Vernon, Esq; in the Liberty of Essington, Parish of Bushbury, in the County of Stafford, into the Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal; such Rail-Ways or Roads to join and communicate with the same Canal at the respective Places hereafter mentioned: One of such Rail-Ways or Roads to pass through the several Townships, Hamlets, Liberties, or Parishes of Essington, Bushbury, Hilton, Wolverhampton, Sharehill, Great and Little Saredon, and Penkridge, and to be continued from the Place near where the Latherford Brook crosses the Road between Sharehill and Calfheath, near to Goody Bridge, in the Liberty of Great Saredon, in the Parish of Penkridge; and to communicate with the said Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal, at or near the same Bridge: One other of the said Rail-Ways or Roads to pass from the said Place near where the said Brook, called Latherford Brook, crosses the said Road, between Sharehill and Calfheath, and to be continued near Latherford Brookside, and communicate with the said Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal, near to where that Brook runs under the said Canal in the Liberty of Little Saredon: And one other Rail-Way or Road to pass from the said Mines of the said Henry Vernon, at Essington aforesaid, through the Townships, Hamlets, Liberties, or Parishes of Essington, Bushbury, Hilton, Wolverhampton, Great and Little Saredon, Penkridge, Hatherton, an extra-Parochial Place called Gale, and to communicate with the said Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal near to Otherton Lock, in the said Parish of Penkridge: And one other Rail-Way or Road to pass from the said Mines of the said Henry Vernon, at Essington aforesaid, through the Townships, Hamlets, Liberties, or Parishes of Essington, Bushbury, Wolverhampton, Wednesfield, and to communicate

with the said Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal in Oxley Moor, near as convenient to Autherley.

Notice is hereby given, that Application is intended to be made to Parliament the next Session to enable the Company of Proprietors of the Stratford-upon-Avon Canal Navigation to alter and amend an Act of Parliament, made in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, "for making and maintaining a Navigable Canal from the Worcester and Birmingham Canal Navigation, in the Parish of Kingstorton, into the Borough of Stratford-upon-Avon, and certain collateral Cuts from the said Canal;" and also to alter and amend another Act of Parliament, made in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, "for making a Navigable Cut from the Stratford-upon-Avon Canal, in the Parish of Lapworth, into the Warwick and Birmingham Canal, in the Manor of Kingswood, in the Parish of Rowington, in the County of Warwick;" and to vary and alter the Line of the Canal, authorised to be made by the said first mentioned Act, through the several Parishes, Townships, and Places of Lapworth, Rowington, Preston Bagot, Wootton Wawen, Bearley, Aston Cantloe, and the Borough of Stratford-upon-Avon, in the County of Warwick; and also to carry the same through Part of the Parish of Clavereton, in the said County of Warwick; and also to alter and vary the Line of the Canal or Cut, authorised to be made by the said last mentioned Act, through the several Parishes, Townships, and Places of Lapworth, Kingswood, and Rowington; and also to empower the said Stratford-upon-Avon Company of Proprietors to raise more Money for completing the said Canal and Cuts; and also to raise Part of the Tolls or Rates authorised to be taken by the said first mentioned Act of Parliament.
