Downing-Street, October 6, 1798.

B^Y Advices received from His Majelty's Minister at Constantinople, dated September 3, it appears, that War has been declared by the Grand Signior against the French; that the French Minister, with his whole Legation, has been fent to the Caftle of the Seven Towers, and that fome French Merchant Ships in the Harbour had been taken Poffeffion of. The Ruffian Auxiliary Squadron was in Sight of Conftantinople on that Day.

Whitehall, October 6, 1798. The King has been pleafed to grant the Dignity of a Baron of the Kingdom of Great Britain to Sir Horatio Nelfon, K. B. Rear-Admiral of the Blue Squadron of His Majefty's Fleet, and the Heirs Male of his Body lawfully begotton, by the Name, Stile, and Title of Baron Nelfon of the Nile, and of Burnham Thorpe, in the County of Norfolk.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament, paffed in the Twenty-fixth Year of His late Ma-jefty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to oblige Ships "more effectually to perform their Quarantine, and "for the better preventing the Plague being "brought from Foreign Parts into Great Britain " or Ireland, or the Ifles of Guernfey, Jerfey, Al-"derney, Sark, or Man," it is, among many other Things, enacted, That all Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Perfons, Gocds, and Merchandizes whatloever, coming or imported into any Port or Place within Great Britain, or any of the Illes before mentioned, from any Place from whence His Majefty, His Heirs or Succeffors, by and with the Advice of His or Their Privy Council, fhall judge it probable that the Infection may be brought, shall be obliged to make their Quarantine in such Place and Places, for such Time and in such Man-

ner as has been, or fhall, from Time to Time, be directed by His Majefty, His Heirs or Succeffors, by His or Their Order or Orders, made in His or Their Privy Council, and notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette; and that until fuch Ships, Veffels, Perfons, Goods; and Merchan-dizes shall have respectively performed, and be dif-charged from such Quarantine; no such Perfons; Goods, or Merchandizes, or any of them, fhall come or be brought on Shore; or go or be put on board any other Ship or Veffel, in any Place within His Majefty's Dominions, unlefs in fuch Manner, and Majetty's Dominions, unleis in fuch trainier, and in fuch Cafes, and by fuch Licence as fhall be di-rected or permitted by fuch Order or Orders made by His Majefty, His Heirs or Succeffors, in Coun-cil, as aforefaid; and that all fuch Ships and Veffels, and the Perfons or Goods coming or imported in, or going or being put on board the fame, and all Ships, Veffels, Boats, and Perfons receiving any Goods or Perfons out of the fame, shall be subject to fuch Orders, Rules, and Directions, concerning Quarantine and the Prevention of Infection, as have been or shall be made by His Majesty, His Heirs and Succeffors, in Council, and notified by Procla-mation, or published in the London Gazette as aforementioned, under fuch Pains and Penalties as are inflicted by the faid Act.

And whereas Information has been received, that a malignant and infectious Difeafe, of the Nature of the Plague, exifts in the City of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennfylvania, within the United States of America; His Majefty, by and with the Advice of his Privy Council, judging it probable that the faid Infection may be brought into this Kingdom from Philadelphia, doth thereupon deem it expe-dient, for the Safety of the Publick Health, to dient, for the Safety of the Publick Fleaitn, to order, and it is hereby ordered, That all Ships, Veffels, Perfons, Goods, and Merchandizes now arrived, or that shall hereafter arrive in any Port of this Kingdom, or the Isles of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark, or Man, from Philadelphia, or any Port within the State of Pennfylvania, do make their Quarantine for Fourteen Days, which is to commence and be computed from the Day each commence and be computed from the Day each Ship or Veffel shall come to anchor in the Place appointed for the Performance of Quarantine, and not before.
