"Enate of the Perfon fo dying, and allo upon " the clear Refidue of the Perfonal Eftate of " every Perfon who thall fo die, whether Tef" tate or :Inteftate, and leave Perfonal Eflate of "the clear Value of 100 l . after dedueting Debts, * Funeral Expences, and other Charges; there " hall be raifed, levied, and collected, for the Ufe " of His Majefty; •His Heirs and Succeffors, the " Yeveral Duties, after the Rates, and in Manner " therein patticularly mentioned:"
AND WHEREAS HIS MAJESTY's COMMISSIONERS FOR MANAGING THE STAMP DUTIES bage Reafon to believe that the Duties which bave become payable under the faid $A \Delta$ upon Legacies. bequeathed, as weell as upon the Refidue of the Perfonal Eflate and Effets of many Perfons who have died fince the faid 26th.
