PROCLAMATION; А For a General Thankfgiving.

GEORGE R.

WE, taking into Our most ferious Consideration the indifpenfable Duty which We owe to Almighty God for the recent and fignal Interpolition of His good Providence, in Addition to the manifold and ineftimable Benefits which these Kingdoms had already received at His Hands; manifested by the Bleffing bestowed on Our Arms in the late memorable Battle, fought in diftant Seas, as well as by the Deliverance of Our Dominions from Invaby the Deliverance of Our Dominions from Inva-fion and from intefline Commotions, through the Energy and Valour of Our Naval and Military Forces, and the Loyalty and Courage of Our faith-ful Subjects, which, exerted in a righteous Caufe, it has pleafed the Divine Goodnefs to crown with Succefs, have thought fit, by the Advice of Our Privy Council, to iffue this Our Royal Proclama-tion, hereby appointing and commanding that a General Thankfgiving to Almighty God, for thefe His Mercies, be obferved throughout England, Wales, and the Town of Berwick upon Tweed, on Thurfday the Twenty-ninth Day of November next: And for the better and more orderly folem-nizing the fame, We have given Directions to the nizing the fame, We have given Directions to the Moft Reverend the Archbishops, and Right Reve-Moft Reverend the Archbifhops, and Right Reve-rend the Bifhops of England, to compofe a Form of Prayer fuitable to the Occafion, to be ufed in all Churches and Chapels, and other Places of Publick Worfhip, and to take Care for the timely differing of the fame throughout their refpective Diocefes; and We do ftrictly charge and command, that the faid Publick Day of Thankfgiving be religioufly ob-ferved by all Our loving Subjects, as they tender the Favour of Almighty God, and upon Pain of fuf-fering fuch Punifhment as we may juftly inflict upon fering fuch Punishment as we may justly inflict upon all fuch who shall contemn or neglect the fame.

And Our Will and Pleafure is, that Our Solicitor do caufe printed Copies hereof to be fent to the Sheriffs of the feveral Shires, Stewarts of Stewartries, and Bailiffs of Regalities, and their Clerk, whom We ordain to fee the fame published ;
