The King has also been pleased to grant unto John Scott, of Bromley, in the County of Kent, Esq; eldest Son and Heir of Jonathan Scott, and Grandson of John Scott, of Shrewsbury, in the County of Salop, Esq; by Dorothy his second Wife, Daughter of Adam Waring, and Aunt of Richard Hill Waring, late of the Hayes, in the said County of Salop, Esquires, deceased, His Royal Licence and Authority, that he and his Issue may (out of grateful and affectionate Respect for the Memory of his said Kinsman Richard Hill Waring, Esq;) take and use the Surname of Waring, and also bear the Arms of Waring; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds' Office.

The King has also been pleased to grant unto Thomas Hayward, of Ryder's-Court, in the Parish of St. Anne, Westminster, His Royal Licence and Authority, that he and his Issue may (in compliance with an Injunction contained in the last Will and Testament of William Danfon, late of Cook's-Court, in the Parish of St. Clement Danes, deceased) take and use the Surname and bear the Arms of Danfon

only, with proper Distinctions; such Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds' Office:
