*from Mr. Thomas Robert Ridge, Commander of*  
*the Badger Excise Cutter, to the Honorable the Com-*  
*missioners of Excise, and transmitted to this Office.*

Honorable Sirs,  
I Beg Leave to inform your Honors, that being  
cruizing with the Badger Cutter on the Morn-  
ing of the 5th Instant; I fell in with and captured  
between Folkestone and Dungeness, a French Lugger  
Privateer of Four Carriage Guns, and manned with  
Eighteen Men, called the Calaisen, Citoyen Jaques  
Guillaume Lamey, Commander, of and from Calais,  
out Eighteen Hours, and had captured nothing;  
quite New, being her first Cruise. I have put in  
here with the Prize owing to its blowing very strong  
from the Southward, and as soon as it moderates, I  
shall proceed to Dover with her.

WHEREAS the Right Honorable the Lords of  
the Committee of Council for hearing Ap-  
peals from the Plantations, &c. have appointed to  
meet in the Council Chamber, at the Cockpit,  
Whitehall, on Tuesday the 22d Day of January,  
1799, at Twelve o'Clock, to hear the Appeal of  
William Brown, Master, and Andrew Spooner,  
Supercargo of the American Ship Five Brothers,  
from a Sentence of the Court or Council of Justice  
at the Cape of Good Hope of the 3d Day of Ja-  
nuary, 1797, upon an Action instituted in the said  
Court by Willem Stephanus Van Ryneveld, Ex  
Officio Attorney-General of the said Cape of Good  
Hope; by which Sentence Eighteen Bales of Ca-  
licoos belonging to the Appellants were confiscated,  
and the said Appellants condemned to pay the triple  
Value thereof, together with Costs: And whereas  
no Appearance hath been hitherto entered for the  
said Respondent to the said Appeal, notwithstanding  
it is near Two Years since the said Sentence was  
pronounced: These are therefore to give Notice to
