THIS Day being appointed for the Celebration of the Anniversary of the Queen's Birth-Day, there was a very splendid and numerous Appearance of the Nobility, Foreign Ministers, and other Persons of Distinction, to compliment Their Majesties upon the Occasion. The Guns at the Tower were fired at One o'Clock. There was a Ball at Court in the Evening, and Illuminations and other Demonstrations of Joy in London and Westminster.
