PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREAS the Time limited by His Majesty's Order in Council of the Thiry-first Day of October last, prohibiting the Transporting into any Parts out of this Kingdom, any Pot-Ashes or Pearl-Ashes, (except as in the said Order is mentioned,) did expire upon the Seventh Day of this instant May: And whereas it is judged expedient that the faid Prohibition should be continued for fome Time longer: His Majesty doth therefore, with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, That no Person or Persons whosoever do, at any Time during the Space of Six Months, to commence from the faid Seventh Day of this inftant May, export, or attempt to export, transport, carry, or convey, or lade or lay on board of any Ship, Vessel, or Boat, in order to be exported, transported, carried, or conveyed out of this Kingdom, any Pot-Ash or Pearl-Ash, without Leave, or Permission being first had and obtained from His Majesty or His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring the Forfeitures inflicted by an Act, paffed in the Thirty-fourth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for indemnifying all Persons who have 46 been concerned in advising or carrying into Exe-" cution an Order of the Lords Commissioners of 44 His Majesty's Treasury respecting the Exportation " of Pot-Ashes or Pearl-Ashes; for preventing Suits " in consequence of the same; for authorizing His " Majesty to prohibit the Exportation or carrying "Coastwise of Pot-Ashes or Pearl-Ashes, and for " making further Provisions relative thereto:" But it is, nevertheless, His Majesty's Pleasure, that nothing herein contained shall extend, or be construed to extend, to prevent the Exportation of the faid Articles to Ireland, or to His Majesty's Islands

His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations in America or the West Indies, or to Newfoundland, or to His Majesty's Forts and Settlements on the Coast of Africa, or to the Island of St. Helena, or to the British Settlements or Factories in the East Indies: Provided that, upon the Exportation of the faid Articles to Ireland, or to His Majesty's Islands of Guernsey, Jersey, Alderney, Sark, or Man, or to His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations in America or the West Indies, or to the Island of Newfoundland, or to His Majesty's Forts and Settlements on the Coast of Africa, or to the Island of St. Helena, or the British Settlements or Factories in the East-Indies, the Exporters of the faid Articles do first make Oath of the true Destination of the same to the Places for which they shall be entered Outwards, before the Entry of the same shall be made; and do give full and fufficient Security, by Bond, to the Satisfaction of the Commissioners of His Majesty's Customs, to carry the faid Articles to the Places for which they are fo entered Outwards, and none other; and fuch Bond shall not be cancelled, or delivered up, until Proof be made to the Satisfaction of the said Commissioners, by the Production, within a Time to be fixed by the faid Commissioners, and specified in the Bond, of a Certificate or Certificates. in fuch Form and Manner as shall be directed by the faid Commissioners, shewing that the said Articles have been all duly landed at the Places for which they were entered Outwards: And the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, and the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the necessary Directions herein as to them may respectively appertain.
