DESCRIPTIONS.

Richard Oliver the Younger.—A dark Complexion, long Face, light Brown curled short Hair, about Six Feet high, about Twenty-six Years of Age, rather thin, but very Boney, and walks very upright.

Richard Barrett the Younger.—A dark Complexion, long thin Face, Black short strait Hair, about Five Feet Six Inches high, about Thirty-two Years of Age, very thin, and rather stoops in his Walk.

Phillip Libby the Younger.—A dark Complexion, round Face, Black short Hair, about Six Feet High, about Forty-two Years of Age, very Stout, and rather stoops in his Walk.

William Smartman the Younger.—A dark Complexion, round Face, long Brown tied Hair, about Five Feet Four Inches high, about Twenty-four Years of Age, and of a middling Stature.

Thomas George.—A dark Complexion, long thin Face, and has a very wide Mouth, short Black Hair, rather bald, about Five Feet Four Inches high, about Fifty Years of Age, of a middling Stature, and has lost Part of the Fore Finger of one of his Hands.

Roger Toms.—A very dark Complexion, long Face, short curled Black Hair, rather Bald, about Five Feet Five or Six Inches high, Forty-five Years of Age, middling Stature, and has a Rupture.

Exchequer-Bill-Office, July 13, 1799.

THE Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury have given Directions for paying off the Sum of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Pounds in Exchequer-Bills, issued pursuant to an Act, passed in the Thirty-eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, for raising an additional Sum of Money by Loans or Exchequer-Bills, for the Service of the Year 1798, and charged on the Aids of the present Year; and that the Principal and Interest on such Bills shall be paid at the Exchequer-Bill-Office, in Saint Margaret's-Street, between the two Palace-Yards, Westminster, on Friday the 2d Day of August next; and Attendance will be given on Friday next the 19th of this instant July, and every succeeding Day until Friday the 26th Instant inclusive, from Ten o'Clock in the Morning until One in the Afternoon, (Sundays and Holidays excepted,) for the Purpose of receiving the same: And for the greater Dispatch, the Bearers of the said Bills are desired to bring Lists thereof, containing the Numbers, in numerical Order, according to the Value of the said Bills, Times of Commencement of Interest, with the Principal Sums and Interest due on such Bills, to be computed at Three Pence Halfpenny by the Day on every 100l.

WHereas it has been humbly represented to the King, that Richard Oliver the Younger, Richard Barrett the Younger, William Smartman the Younger, Philip Libby the Younger, Thomas George, and Roger Toms, of Polperrow, in the County of Cornwall, Mariners, and lately belonging to a Smuggling Vessel called the Lottery, stand charged upon Oath with being concerned in the wilful Murder of Humphry Glinn, late a Boatman belonging to the Six-Oared Boat in the Service of the Customs, stationed at Cawsand, on the 26th of December last, between the Hours of Ten and Eleven at Night, off Penlee Point, on the Coast of Cornwall, by firing from on board the said Vessel called the Lottery with Muskets at the said Boat.

His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the above-named Persons, is hereby pleased to promise his most gracious Pardon to any One of the said Offenders, (except Richard Oliver the Younger, the Master of the said Vessel, and Richard Barrett the Younger, one of the Owners thereof, and the Persons who actually fired,) who shall discover his Accomplice or Accomplices, or be the Means of any One or more of
